I am directed to refer this Ministry's letter dated 10.10.2019 (copy enclosed) on the subject mentioned above.

2. In this regard it is clarified here that the instructions of Principal Account Office Ministry of rural Development, forwarded to States were only for the Central Sector Schemes and not for the Centrally Sponsored Schemes.

3. NSAP is a 100% funded Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS), hence, you are requested to follow the prevailing banking arrangements used by the State prior to the letter dated 10.10.2019 of this Ministry.


**Subject:** Banking arrangements of the State/District Level Implementing Agencies handling Central Sector Schemes of various Ministries/Departments of the Government of India.
